



Advice to Coaches

21st November 2023

South Australian Marine Safety regulations require boat drivers to have an Australian Boat drivers licence. Adelaide Sailing Club has negotiated an exemption for international drivers for the period of the Championship.

Adelaide Sailing Club is also able to accredit International drivers through the Australian Sailing Power boat Handling qualification to enable them to drive outside the Championship period. This is only possible after the coach registers.

We have applied for a restricted waters zone for the race courses and have been able to negotiate an exemption from Australian registration for those International coach boats which have been shipped to Adelaide.

All boats must carry the required safety equipment specified by SA Marine Safety, and by the Coach and Support Boat Regulations and Notice of Race.

South Australian Boating Regulations

Safety equipment requirement

-  Approved lifejacket per person (level 100 or above) ^
-  Bucket with line attached or bilge pump(s)
-  Fire bucket
-  One approved fire extinguisher (if engine fitted or cooking facilities on board). [Size requirements and standards apply.](#)
-  Anchor and cable
-  Waterproof and buoyant torch
-  Two handheld red flares and two orange smoke signal flares (flares must be in date)
-  Paddles/oars or another type of propulsion (if your vessel is under six metres)
