Boat Drop off, Parking, Storage and SI's

Sailing Instructions

The SI's will be available via the Sailor App and McCrae YC website by 1800hrs on 25 November.

Early Boat Drop Off

Boats can be dropped off at the club before the event, between 15:00hrs and 20:00hrs on Friday 26 November. We encourage you to take this option if possible as it will ease traffic and trailer parking on Saturday morning.

Saturday morning arrival

There will be McCYC traffic marshals to welcome you and provide instructions for unloading and trailer parking.

You will be asked to unload boats from trailers in the car park in front of the club and walk your boats into the yard.

Parking

There is ample free parking in unsealed car parks surrounding the club or along Pt Nepean Road. There is an overflow car park in Bartels Street, directly opposite the club (see map below). With COVID travel restrictions now eased the Mornington Peninsula is experiencing increased traffic on all its roads and demand for parking.

Please allow plenty of time and ensure you comply with parking signs and road rules. Parking Officers will be on patrol and you don't want a parking ticket to spoil your day!

Boat Storage

Competitors boats will be stored in the boat yard and on the front lawn. Security lighting will illuminate the area at night.
