Yachting Western Victoria invites Yachties with Off-the-beach Monohulls or Catamarans and Trailables to the 62<sup>nd</sup> Annual Easter Regatta.

The Organising Authority is Yachting Western Victoria (YWV) and the regatta will be conducted on Lake Bullen Merri, Camperdown.

### 1. RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 Australian Sailing Special Regulations Part 2 for Off the Beach Boats shall apply.

#### 2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to all off-the-beach monohulls, off-the-beach catamarans and trailable yachts.
- 2.2 The fleet will sail in Divisions with classes allocated once entry numbers are known and may include:
  - a) Catamarans
  - b) Fast Monos
  - c) Other Monos including trailables
  - d) Juniors
- 2.3 Eligible boats may enter online via the Sailor app at: www.clubops.com.au/event/GHJVT

#### **3. ENTRY FEE**

- 3.1 The entry fee is \$100 per boat.
- 3.2 junior entry will be \$40 per boat
- 3.3 All entries received prior to **25<sup>th</sup> March 2024** are eligible for a discounted entry fee of \$80.

#### **4. SCHEDULE**

- 4.1 All competitors who have not entered on line, shall complete registration at the Rotunda between 1000hrs and 1200hrs on the 29<sup>th</sup> March 2024.

4.3 No warning signal will be made later than 1200hrs on Monday 10<sup>th</sup> April 2023.

#### **5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

Sailing Instructions will be available via the Sailor App (select 'Regatta' & '62<sup>nd</sup> Annual Camperdown Easter Regatta').

#### 6. VENUE

The Racing Area will be the waters of Lake Bullen Merri.

#### 7. THE COURSES

Courses will be sailed as detailed on the whiteboard in the Rotunda.

#### 8. SCORING SYSTEM

- 8.1 the low point scoring system of appendix A RRS will apply
- A minimum of three races are required to be completed to constitute the regatta.
- 8.2 When fewer than four races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of all her race scores.
- 8.3 When four or five races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of all her race scores excluding her worst score.

#### 9. PRIZES

- 9.1 Prizes will be awarded for each race and Division at the discretion of the Organising Authority.
- 9.2 All races are supported by DYSC Marine Supplies

#### **10. RIGHTS TO USE NAME AND LIKENESS**

In participating in an Event, a competitor automatically grants the Organising Authority and the sponsors of the Event, the right in perpetuity, to make, use and show from time to time at their discretion, any motion pictures, still pictures and live, taped or film television and other reproductions of him/her during the period of the competition for the said Event in which the competitor participates and in all material related to the said Event without compensation.

#### **11. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 3, Decision to Race. The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

#### **12. INSURANCE**

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$5,000,000 (recommended \$10,000,000) per event or the equivalent. Competitors may be required to produce evidence of such insurance and any competitor not holding this cover shall withdraw their entry.

#### **13. AMENDMENTS**

Any amendments to this Notice of Race shall be posted via the Sailor App.
